### Course Description

Intermediate 1 will review general math concepts and introduce such topics as rates, proportionality, solving equations, geometry, probability, and statistics.

### Materials You Will Need

- A two-or-three-inch three-ring binder. It must have a divider for each of your classes. It must also have extra, loose leaf paper.
- Pencils, Erasers, and Pens
- Composition Notebook.

### Grading Policy

Your grade will be based on mastery of concepts. Each test will have different concepts I expect the students to master. Skills checks will be given throughout the unit to help me to know who will need some extra help before the test is given. A small part of the student grade will be based on homework and participation in class. The grading scale for this class is as follows:

### Homework

Homework is a necessary part of understanding mathematics. It is an opportunity for you to practice the skills learned in the classroom. You will be given homework on a regular basis. Homework is due the class period after it is assigned. If it is not turned in that day, it will be considered late. All late homework will be due the day of the unit test. No late work will be accepted after this time.

### Participation

You will be expected to participate every day you are in class. It is important to be in class every day to learn all of the information. If you fail to participate, your citizenship grade may go down.

### Starters

Starters will be given at the first of class. Students are responsible to be on time to class to have the full time to complete the starter.

### Binder

Binders will be checked periodically through the year to see if the notebook is organized.

### Unit Tests

After each unit, the students will be given a unit test. The students must pass this quiz with an 80% in order to have mastered this concept. Students who do not reach that 80% mark will need to come in for remediation.

### **Absent Work**

In order to turn in work for absences, you must fill out a slip **and have me sign it**. If this slip is not on your assignment, you will not receive credit for the assignment. If you are absent on the day of a quiz or test, you must come and re-take the assessment. You have one week to make up a quiz or test.

### **Late Work**

To turn in late work, you must fill out a slip. If this slip isn't on your homework, you won't receive credit. All late work is due the day of the Unit Test.
